Guilt – "the legal and moral condition that results from a violation of God's law."

1) The legal condition:

When we sin, we are guilty

Romans 3:23 and separated from God Romans 6:23 but in the gift of his Son, that guilt is removed (when we accept the gift.)

2) The moral condition:

a) If guilt comes from God's conviction, we must pay attention
 Psalm 38:1-10, 21, 22
 John 8:2-11
 with 2Chronicles 7:14

 b) If guilt comes because we have forgotten God's promises, we must remind ourselves of them John 21:15-17 with 1 John 1:9

Psalm 103:12 Matthew 11:28, 29 Romans 8:1, 2, 33-35, 38, 39

- c) If guilt comes because those around us try to impose it on us, we must be sure we are in the right Matthew 26:57-63a Luke 23:32-34a
- d) If guilt comes because Satan is trying to disable us, we must resist him
 Matthew 4:11 with 1 Peter 5:8, 9
