Overcoming Doubt BY PAYING ATTENTION TO SCIENCE

Four hundred years ago, a Frenchman named René Descartes found that he could doubt absolutely everything except for his own existence. The very acting of doubt proved that he existed, so he came up with the saying, I think therefore I am.

With that realization, Descartes and all who follow him plunge into a pit of despair. If nothing but my own existence is sure, then nothing including my existence has real value and meaning. To see how Descartes' doubt has permeated our society all you have to do is look around and read the news.

Descartes tried to climb out of his pit by putting his faith in human reason. Human reason can go a long way; but it cannot answer the BIG questions of life and rescue us from despair.

Over the past few decades, there have been a number of points on which science has actually "caught up" with the Bible.

BIG BANG THEORY

The first three words of the Bible teach that there was a moment when the universe did not exist, which was followed by a moment when it did exist. In contrast to that, secular scientists once believed that the universe is eternal. Then a young scientist, Stephen Hawking, came along and confirmed what the Bible taught.

INTELLIGENT DESIGN

The first verse of the Bible teaches that the universe is the work of an intelligent Creator. In contrast to that, secular scientists still believe that it is the product of random chance. Based on the remarkable complexity of things, especially the cells of living organisms, many scientists, including Michael Behe, are disagreeing and returning to belief in an intelligent Creator.

THE GOLDILOCK PRINCIPLE
