- 1) Husbands and wives – Col. 3:18,19 with Ephesians 5:22-33
  - A) Wives, submit to your husband, as to the Lord
    - Respecting God-given role
    - Unconditional love, unconditional respect
  - B) Husbands, love your wife as Christ loved the church
    - Not just as you love your own body Ephesians 5:28
    - Not just as you love yourself Ephesians 5:33
    - But as Christ loved the church Ephesians 5:25
      - >giving his life

  - A) Children
    - Obedience matters to God
    - cf. Saul, 1 Samuel 15:22
  - B) Parents
    - Proverbs 22:6 – in the way he should go
    - v.21 with Ephesians 6:4 – do not embitter, exasperate

  - A) Employees
    - Not only when their eye is on you
    - Not only to win their favor
  - B) Employers
    - As a brother, as to the Lord
