Application of Phil 4:21-23

1. Do you have a warmth of love and care for other believers, both those at the Chapel and also people you know who attend other churches?

2. Are your greetings to other believers sincere or does it display a heart that does not care for others? If you don't care for others, ask God to examine your heart as to why you do not love His people.

3. Reflect on God's saving grace in your life and thank Him for His Son who died on the cross to bring you into relationship with Him!

4. Do you accept God's grace being sufficient for you needs? That His grace will never run dry and that He will always provide the grace you need when you need it?

5. What is it this day you need grace for? Read Heb 4:15-16 to remind you of the grace available for our times of need! *Repeat this application as many times as needed*
