# **Application of Ephesians 2:4-5**

- 1. Think about (and maybe write out) your testimony of salvation. Use Eph 2:1-10 as a template, starting first with your life before you were a believer (Eph 2:1-3), the "But God" experience of your salvation (Eph 2:4-9) and now how you are living for God (Eph 2:10). Pray for an opportunity to share this testimony with someone this week.
- 2. Reflect on the greatness of your sin and what you deserve and then reflect on the greatness of God and His salvation and thank Him for what He has done
- 3. Are there any challenges in your life that you can remember "But God..." to encourage and comfort you this week?
- 4. How well do you know and accept God's love? Is there anything in your life you've done that you don't think God can love you for? Are you trying to earn God's love? Read, pray and memorise verses to help overcome any weakness in this area e.g. John 3:16; Rom 8:38-39; Rom 5:8; 1 John 3:1; 4:9-10
- 5. Because of what God has done for you, what are some responses you can give to Him?
