Application of 1 John 2:6

1. In 1 John 2:3-6 John provides a simple test to be sure of your salvation... If you are a true believer you will follow God's Word. According to this test, how sure can you be of your salvation? 2. In what ways can you follow Jesus' example more closely in the following areas of life? Look up the verses that are applicable to you and pray God will help you become more like Christ in living like Him
 - a. Husbands (Eph 5:24-33)
 - b. Wives (1 Peter 2:21-3:2)
 - c. Children (Luke 2:51)
 - d. Employees (1 Peter 2:18-24)
 - e. Humility (Phil 2:3-8)
 - f. Service (John 13:35)
 - g. Sacrificial love (Eph 5:25; 1 John 3:16)
 - h. Forgiveness (Col 3:16)
3. Are there other specific areas of your life that you would like to know how Jesus responded to in a similar situation? Try to find a passage or story in the NT that gives an example of how Jesus acted. If not, ask me or another mature believer for help.
4. What steps would you like to take to become more like Jesus e.g. more time in the Bible? Meeting with other believers? Committing to prayer, service and evangelism?

Reading this week: Read through the Gospel of John this week and write down specific ways Jesus lived e.g. Who did He interact with? How did He interact with them? How did He prioritise spiritual well-being? What were His emotions like?
