Sunday Service Registration

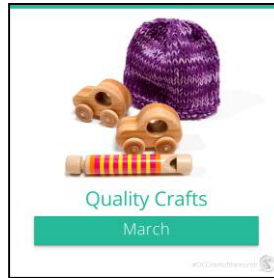
