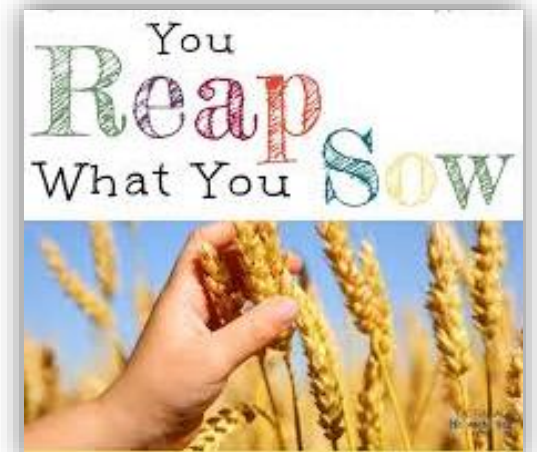
Volunteering
